1. Abe Goes West

 Doggone Abe has gone West! Our new West Coast IPA packs a generous amount of Citra, Centennial, and CTZ hops. Abe Goes West delivers bright balanced flavors of orange, grapefruit, and fresh cut springtime grass.

2. Rising Sun Saison

A refreshingly tart Farmhouse style ale. This beer is seasonal and perfect for the start of warmer weather. The flavor profile is fruity (lemon/orange) and spicy (peppery). Hop presence and aroma is low.

3. New Trail: Summer Chill Factor

• This Cold IPA is brewed to bring you the Summer Chill Factor. Cold IPA is brewed with a lighter malt bill, fermented colder than normal IPA, and dry-hopped with bright new age hops; Nectaron, Crystal, HBC 586, and Citra. A late and aggressive dry-hopping schedule creates huge aroma, candied orange peel and light tropical character, all showcased by a body that is slightly complex yet clean. Summer Chill Factor creates an extra crushable and crispy IPA.

A Hazy New England Style Ipa with Azacca and El Dorado hops, then double dry-hopped at over 3 pounds/barrel with the same. Tastes like ripe melon and mango gummies on a bed of liquid tangerine puff pastry!

5. 1763 Lager

Vienna style lager made with 4 malts and 2 hops. Light copper in color. Flavor profile: Subtle hops, crisps, bready, with a slightly sweet finish!

6. Lincoln Way Wheat

American wheat beer, made with 3 malts, 2 hops and a Hefeweizen yeast combined to produce
a smooth, easy drinking wheat beer. "Hefe" means "with yeast" which gives the beer its
unfiltered and cloudy appearance. Hazy light straw color, banana/fruit and slight clove ester
profile.
